## 1 Futagoji Temple 3-D



Futagoji Temple, located on the slopes of Mt. Futago (the highest peak of the Kunisaki Peninsula) is famous for its stunning autumn colors. Its vast grounds feature the "Seven Wonders of Futagoji" and magnificent stone Nio statues, and it is also known as a temple for prayers for conception and childbirth.

## 4 Kyusentoji Temple Ruins 2-D



On the slopes of Mt. Fudo lies the site of an ancient temple, now part of the Rokugo Manzan Fureai Forest Park. Visitors can see half-relief stone Nio statues, Gorinto pagodas, and the Itsutsuji Fudo deity. The present Sentoji Temple is located at the foot of Mt. Fudo, along the prefectural road.

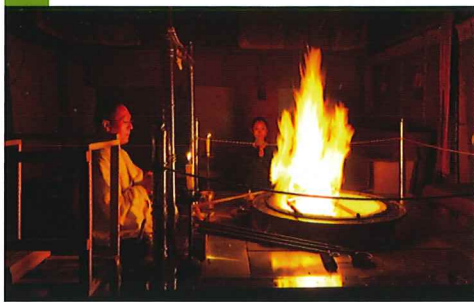
## 7 Yayoi no Mura Kunisaki City Historic Experience and Learning Hall 3-E



Visitors can experience ancient life through activities such as Magatama bead making and fire starting. The adjacent park features reconstructed dwellings and storehouses from the Yayoi period.

Monjusenji Temple, one of Japan's three great Monju temples, offers blessings for academic success, good relationships, and safe childbirth. Its principal deity, Monju Bosatsu, is a secret Buddha image unveiled only once every twelve years in the Year of the Rabbit.

## 5 Baien no Sato 4-D



Nestled in a quiet mountain valley, this inn offers "Umeno-yu," a mineral-rich hot bath using spring water from Mt. Futago, and a popular Sunday-only buffet of seasonal dishes. It also houses the Tenkyukan Observatory, featuring one of the largest telescopes in Oita Prefecture.

## 8 Kunimi Furusato Folk Museum 1-D



This museum is housed in a former manor built in the early Meiji period. It features exhibits on Petro Kasui Kibe—the first Japanese missionary to travel to Jerusalem—along with folk tools, farming implements, and artifacts from the Onizuka Tumulus that introduce the culture of Kunimi Town and the Rokugo Manzan heritage.

## 3 Senpukuji Temple 3-E



Originally founded as a training monastery, this temple prospered during the Edo period as the Kyushu head temple of the Soto sect. Visitors can experience authentic Zen meditation in its meditation hall.

## 6 Kunimi Onsen "Akane no Sato" Yu no Sato Keisen 2-C 2-D



This inn in Kunisaki City offers day-use hot spring bathing and is known as a historic healing spa. The two facilities are only a three-minute drive apart.

## 9 Statue of Petro Kasui Kibe 1-D



In the 17th century, Petro Kasui Kibe became the first Japanese pilgrim to reach Jerusalem and later Rome. He returned to Japan during a time of Christian persecution and was martyred in Edo (now Tokyo). Born in Kibe, Kunimi-machi, he is honored with this statue and is often called "the Japanese Marco Polo" for his remarkable journeys.

## 10 Touinryou 1-D



This three-story wooden house, built about 140 years ago, now serves as a hub for art in Kunimi-machi. It features exhibitions mainly by local artists and offers the town's specialty "Tako-meshi Gozen" (octopus rice set meal) in its café.
